In the book, each of the animals can be seen on Jacob's fan.

Task: Create a poster for your school or home that shows The Life Cycle of a Frog or An Ephemeral Pond.

Frog Poster

- Teach someone about the life cycle of the frog
 Make sure that you use a circle to indicate a cycle
 Label your diagrams at each stage (subheadings)
 Make it big enough so that people can see it
 Use interesting materials to illustrate your poster
